construction, operation and maintenance of the commuter facilities

4. Class A Scavenger License Renewal

Purpose: A motion is requested to renew the Class A Scavenger License assigned to Allied Waste,

Purpose: An ordinance amendment has been prepared pertaining to the disposition of personal

4. Increase in Municipal Motor Fuel Tax (aka Gasoline Tax)

Action Requested: Approval by Ordinance

Purpose: Staff has scheduled a public hearing for December 5, 2006, to consider an ordinance

which will increase the Municipal Motor Fuel Tax, which is also known as the *gasoline* tax from 1 ½ cents (\$0.015) per gallon to 2 ½ cents (\$0.025) per gallon for the purpose of providing revenues to support the Transportation Fund. The public hearing is required

under the Council's Home Rule Policy
