#### **SYNOPSIS**

A motion is requested to accept the proposal submitted by Century Post 503, Veterans of Foreign Wars to operate as the vendor of the Bingo Tent games at the 2007 Heritage Festival.

#### STRATEGIC PLAN ALIGNMENT

Downers Grove Vision 2021 identified the principles of an *Authentic Downtown and Hometown Feeling* with the supporting means of: *Vibrant Community Focal Point for Bringing Residents and Guests together; Destination for Eating and Entertainment Both Indoor and outdoor and Strong Community Events Bringing Residents and Generations Together.* 

#### **FISCAL IMPACT**

The vendor will reimburse the Village in the amount of \$1,500 for the rental of the tent, tables and chairs. The Bingo tent is an attraction at the festival and it generates minimal revenue which goes to the vendor.

#### **BACKGROUND**

Through a Request for Proposal sent out this year, Century Post 503, Veterans of Foreign Wars was the only Not –For-Profit organization to submit a proposal to operate the 2007 Bingo tent at Heritage Festival. Post #503 has operated the Bingo tent for the past several years, providing excellent service.
