### **SYNOPSIS**

An ordinance has been prepared to amend the Village Code to implement Park Speed Zone speed limits (20 Miles per Hour) at Washington and Wallingford Parks.

## STRATEGIC PLAN ALIGNMENT

The Vision for 2021 identified *Unique Neighborhoods*. A supporting objective of this statement is *Top Quality Infrastructure Tailored to Each Neighborhood*.

### FISCAL IMPACT

The fiscal impact resulting from this action would be approximately \$500. The adopted FY 2007 General Fund budget has sufficient funding for the required signs to be fabricated and installed.

### **UPDATE & RECOMMENDATION**

This item was discussed at the June 12, 2007 Workshop Meeting. Staff recommends approval on the June 19, 2007 agenda.

### **BACKGROUND**

The Village Council recently enacted a change to the Village Code to include Park Speed Zones (20 MPH) and implemented this at three parks within the Village. The Park District has requested consideration of two additional parks for consideration and this matter was presented to the Parking & Traffic Commission on April 11, 2007. The Downers Grove Park District requested the Village amend the Code to include Park Speed Zones at Wallingford Park and Washington Park. The Park District selected these parks as involving vehicular/pedestrian conflicts which would benefit directly from reduced Park Zone speed limits. The objective of these Park Speed Zone speed limits is to enhance pedestrian safety by reducing motorist speed. This condition is especially needed where children and/or families must cross streets and also where the parks themselves do not have internal parking spaces available. In accordance with the State Code permitting these Park Speed Zones they are in effect "On any day when children are present and within 50 feet of motorized traffic". These zones will be enforced by our Police Department on a random or complaint basis similar to the same way they enforce School Speed Zones.

Staff will be installing Park Speed Zone speed limit signs on Elm Street and Franklin Street for Washington Park, and also on Elm Street north of Ogden Avenue for Wallingford Park.

# AN ORDINANCE ADDING PARK ZONE SPEED LIMITS

BE IT ORDAINED by the Village Council of the Village of Downers Grove in DuPage County,

Illinois, as follows: (Additions are indicated by shading/underline; deletions by strikeout):

# Section 1. That Section 14.36. is hereby amended to read as follows:

# 14.36. Speed limits on certain streets--Twenty miles per hour.

It is hereby determined and declared that twenty miles per hour (20 mph) is a reasonable and safe absolute maximum speed limit for vehicles on the following street(s):

Bates Place, throughout its length.

Blackburn Avenue, between 75th and 73rd Streets.

Braemoor Drive, throughout its length.

Breasted Avenue, throughout its length.

Brookbank Road, between Gilbert Street and Maple Avenue.

Clyde Drive, throughout its length.

Cumnor Road, at Whitlock Park.

Elm Street, at Wallingford Park.

Elm Street, at Washington Park.

Fairview Avenue "frontage" Road south of 75th Street to Florence Avenue.

Forest Avenue, between Franklin Street and Prairie Avenue.

# Franklin Street, at Washington Park.

Grand Avenue, between 75th and 73rd Streets.

Hartford Road, throughout its length.

Hathaway Lane, throughout its length.

Linden Place, between Chicago Avenue and Austin Street.

Loomes Avenue, throughout its length.

Mistwood Court, throughout its length.

Mistwood Lane, throughout its length.

Mistwood Place, throughout its length.

Nash Street, throughout its length.

Park Avenue, at Randall Park.

Prideham Street, throughout its length.

Randall Road, at Randall Park.
