SYNOPSIS

An ordinance has been prepared to amend the Village Code to repeal the Design Review Committee and Appearance Code.

STRATEGIC PLAN ALIGNMENT

UPDATE & RECOMMENDATION

This item was discussed at the September 25, 2007 Workshop. Staff recommends approval on the October 2, active agenda.

BACKGROUND

The Village has a Design Review Committee (DRC) and Appearance Code for the downtown. The DRC and Appearance Code have not been administered since the fall of 2005. In April 2005, the Village Council established the Architectural Design Review Board (ADRB) to review the Village's need for design guidelines and design review. The ADRB reviewed the DRC and Appearance Code and noted these items were no longer effective. In December 2006, the Village Council reviewed the ADRB's recommendations and made a motion directing staff to prepare an ordinance to repeal the Appearance Code and DRC. The terms of all members of the DRC expired in July of 1999 or prior.

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING THE DESIGN REVIEW COMMITTEE

BE IT ORDAINED by the Village Council of the Village of Downers Grove in DuPage County,

Illinois, as follows: (Additions are indicated by shading/underline; deletions by strikeout):

Section 1. Section 7.39. is hereby repealed in its entirety

7.39. Definitions.
For the purposes of this article, the following words and phrases shall have the meanings respectively
ascribed to them by this section:
Central design area. The area bounded by Franklin Street on the north, Elm Street, as extended, or
the east, Summit Street, as extended, on the south, and Saratoga Avenue, as extended, on the west.

Committee. The design review committee.
Director. The Director of Community Development.
Exterior design feature. An essential and visible part of the exterior of a building or structure
including the architectural style and general arrangement of any portion of the building or structure as is oper
to view from a public street, alley, place or way. Exterior design features may include, but are not limited to
the kind, color, and texture of building materials, type of windows, doors, lights, colors, signs and othe
fixtures appurtenant to such building or structure.
Kind for kind. In evaluating proposed improvements to an exterior design feature, an improvement
which causes the building to appear so substantially similar to such building or structure as it existed prior to
the improvement as to be indistinguishable therefrom.
Person. Any individual, firm, partnership, corporation or trust. (Ord. No. 3310, § 1.)

Section 2. Section 7.41. is hereby repealed in its entirety

7.41. Design Review Committee; created; composition.

A Design Review Committee is hereby created, which committee shall consist of seven members, appointed by the Village Manager, for staggered terms of three years each. Members shall hold office for their designated terms and until their successors have been appointed. (Ord. No. 3310, § 1.)

Section 3. Section 7.42. is hereby repealed in its entirety

7.42. Powers and duties. The committee shall have the following powers and duties: (a) To hold public hearings on and make recommendations for any amendments to the Appearance Code adopted in Section 7-43. (b) To consult and work with the Director of Community Development in the review of applications for permits of any construction, additions, alterations or enlargements affecting exterior design features in the

- (c) To consult with and cooperate with other boards and commissions, Village departments and personnel, and any other governmental bodies on matters affecting the appearance of buildings and structures under this article.
 - (d) To review exterior design drawings, landscape and site plans, materials, colors, photographs or

any other necessary documents or items for any proposed construction, additions, alterations or enlargements affecting exterior design features in the central design area. (e) To encourage applicants to utilize the standards and guidelines set forth in the Appearance Code, and to assist applicants in the application of the Appearance Code to their properties. (f) To conduct meetings, as necessary, on the issuance of certificates as provided in Section 7-44. (g) To prepare an annual report summarizing the changes made in the central design area, the number of certificates of approval which were issued and the number which were denied. This annual report will be placed on public file by the Village Council. (Ord. No. 3310, § 1.)
Section 4. Section 7.43. is hereby repealed in its entirety
7.43. Appearance Code adopted; amendments. (a) The Appearance Code dated January 20, 1997, is hereby adopted to govern exterior design features for properties in the Central Design Area as designated in Section 7-40 hereof. (b) The Appearance Code may be amended from time to time by the Village Council, upon recommendation of the Committee, and after a public hearing thereon. (Ord. No. 3310, § 1.)
Section 5. Section 7.44. is hereby repealed in its entirety
7.44. Regulatory powers of the design review committee over exterior design features, buildings and structures.
(a) A certificate of approval must be obtained for any of the following changes or alterations to an
exterior design feature in the central design area:
(1) If such change or alteration would otherwise require a building permit;
(2) If such change or alteration involves exterior surface improvements to the building,
including painting, siding, or roofing visible from the street, and such improvements are not kind for kind;
(3) If such changes or alterations involve new landscaping or lighting, or replacement of
existing landscaping or lighting, which is not kind for kind;
(4) If there is any other change or alteration having an impact on an exterior design feature
which is not kind for kind.
(b) The procedure for obtaining a certificate of approval shall be as follows:
(1) The Director of Community Development, upon receipt of an application for a permit or
permits as required by ordinance, shall determine and advise the applicant whether, under the provisions of
this article, a certificate of approval is required.
(2) When a certificate of approval is required for exterior painting which is not kind for
kind, but which is in conformance with the Appearance Code for "color palette", the Director of Community
Development shall issue such certificate.
(3) When a certificate is required, the Director shall forward the application, including all
preliminary exterior drawings, sketches, photographic examples, landscape or site plans and materials to the
committee. The committee shall within twenty one days, make a recommendation to the Village Manager to
issue or not issue a certificate. The committee may make recommendations as to changes in the exterior
drawings, sketches, landscaping, site plans, materials and colors which, in the opinion of the committee,
would tend to effect the general purposes of the Appearance Code.
(4) Upon receipt of the committee's recommendation, the Village Manager shall issue a
certificate if it is found that:
a. The applicant's plans are substantially consistent with the Appearance Code;
b. The proposed exterior design features of the project are suitable and compatible
with the character of neighboring buildings and structures existing or under construction, and with the

c. The exterior design features of the project will not be detrimental to the

character of the central design area, and contributes to the favorable environment of the area;
