#### SYNOPSIS

A resolution has been prepared to authorize the execution of the 2008 Amusement Ride Vendor Agreement, with Astro Amusement Company, Inc., to operate the amusement midway at the 2008 Heritage Festival.

#### STRATEGIC PLAN ALIGNMENT

Downers Grove Vision 2022 identified the principles of an Authentic Downtown and Hometown Feeling with the supporting means of: Vibrant Community Focal Point for Bringing Residents and Guests together; Destination for Eating and Entertainment Both Indoor and Outdoor and Strong Community Events Bringing Residents and Generations Together.

#### FISCAL IMPACT

The FY08 General Fund budget provides \$451,750 in expenses with \$425,900 expected revenues. The proposed Amusement Ride vendor is projected to generate \$145,200 in revenue for the Village of Downers Grove.

#### RECOMMENDATION

Approval on the February 5, 2008 consent agenda.

#### **BACKGROUND**

Through a Request for Proposal process, two amusement companies submitted proposals: North American Midway Entertainment d/b/a Astro Amusements Co., Inc. and All Around Amusement Company. The Community Events Commission at its December 13, 2007 meeting recommended utilizing Astro Amusement Company as the 2008 Heritage Festival Amusement Ride Vendor.

Astro Amusement Company has provided quality service and has proven its capability to handle an event of Heritage Festival's magnitude. One reference was negative for All Around Amusement Company.

The terms of the contract include the following:

- The Village will receive \$600 per concession (game) at the event and \$1,000 per food concession, along with ride revenue receipts of 40 percent up to \$100,000; 43 percent up to \$150,000; 45 percent up to \$225,000; and 50 percent over \$225,000 of the gross receipts.
- Astro employees having contact with children will be placed through a fingerprint/ background check; the cost will be split between the Village and Astro. At the Village's discretion, Astro employees may only be checked through the National Sex Offender database.
- Astro will support Heritage Festival event by donating \$500 in sponsorship for ten portable toilets and 550 special tickets for sponsorship.
- Astro will provide the following: the Bear Show with seating area, the Misting Tents and the Pipe Organ, all of which add to the attractiveness of the midway area.

- Thursday Night Pay-On-Price \$17.00
- Friday Morning Kiddie Pay-One-Price \$12.00
- Day-of Sheet of Tickets (22) \$22.00
- Single Ticket \$1.00

- 4. That all resolutions or parts of resolutions in conflict with the provisions of this Resolution are hereby repealed.
- 5. That this Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage as provided by law.
