#### **SYNOPSIS**

A resolution has been prepared authorizing submission of a grant application to the Bureau of Justice Assistance requesting federal funding in the amount of \$2,500 to support 50 percent of the total costs to purchase ten bullet proof vests.

#### STRATEGIC PLAN ALIGNMENT

The Five Year Plan and Goals for 2006-2011 identified *Preservation Of The Residential And Neighborhood Character*. A supporting objective of this goal is *Safe And Secure Neighborhoods*.

#### **FISCAL IMPACT**

The FY08 General Fund Budget allocates \$10,000 for the purchase of twenty bullet proof vests. The total estimated project cost for the purchase of ten bulletproof vests is \$5,000 of which the Village is required to provide \$2,500 as the minimum match.

#### RECOMMENDATION

Approval on the April 15, 2008, consent agenda.

#### **BACKGROUND**

Over the past seven years, the Village was awarded \$29,235 in grant funds toward the purchase of 141 bulletproof vests as part of the Bulletproof Vest Partnership Program. The Village provides 81 officers and 4 Community Service Officers with vests. With the warranty being five years, the Village purchases twenty vests per year to maintain proper replacement. This year the Bureau of Justice Assistance (BJA) limited the Village's total purchase value to a maximum of \$5,140 or an estimated ten vests. Even though BJA limited the purchase to ten vests, the Police Department budgeted for a total of twenty vests in 2008 to maintain proper replacement.
