BACKGROUND

As part of the preliminary planning efforts associated with TCD3, staff made a brief presentation on May 27, 2008 (see attached) that provided a general overview for the TCD3/Comprehensive Plan concept. Earlier this year, staff also conducted a request proposal (RFP) process to select a consultant to assist with the creation of an updated Comprehensive Plan for the Village. Among other things, the TCD3 process was envisioned as a source of valuable information from the community that would help to inform and support to the development of the Comprehensive Plan update. This arrangement would allow for discussion of topics that might not feed directly into the Comprehensive Plan, but represent important community issues that could further be addressed by the Village or other participating units of government.

The recommended facilitator/consulting firm, Houseal Lavigne Associates, was given an opportunity to discuss their proposal at the June 10 Council Workshop. Based on the discussion that took place among the Council, it was determined that further definition of the scope of the TCD3 process was needed in order to develop a clear schedule of activities for the process and finalize the contract with the consultant to clearly outline the scope of services to be performed. As a result, staff has provided the following information to assist Council in a discussion of TCD3 activities.

Prior to the commencement of any of the activities listed below, a TCD3 Oversight Committee will be formed. This group will meet on a regular basis and provide guidance throughout the process. It is envisioned that the Committee will consist of elected officials and/or key staff from the participating units of local government in Downers Grove, several members of the community-at-large and the selected facilitator. Regular updates of Committee and process activities will be provided to the Village Council and other units of government.

Along with the Village, the Library, Park District, School Districts and Sanitary District serve as important community partners and will receive special focus during this step of the process. Specifically, an interview/ questionnaire and meeting format will be employed to identify issues and concerns shared by these entities that share overlapping jurisdiction.

A Business Workshop will be conducted for the owners and operators/managers of businesses located in Downers Grove. Business owners and managers offer a unique perspective on issues that may be of vital importance to the overall economic health of the community. This portion of the process will be held in conjunction with the EDC, Chamber of Commerce and Downtown Management Corporation.

3e Student Workshops November 2008 Yes

Students are key citizens of the Village and should be engaged in the outreach process. In cooperation with the schools, in-class workshops could be set-up to engage students and ask them questions about the Village and get their thoughts regarding life in Downers Grove; what they like; what they don't like; and what they would like to see done differently. Workshops/focus groups could be held for elementary, junior high, and senior high schools.

3f Neighborhood Workshops Jan. – Mar. 2008 Yes

A series of focus group workshops will be conducted for neighborhoods throughout the Village. The purpose is to allow for a more detailed discussion and examination of the issues and concerns pertaining to each of the different neighborhoods. The residents, business persons, and property owners of each area will be encouraged to attend.

3g Summary of Community Outreach Mar 2008 Yes

After all of the workshops, retreats, surveys, interviews, and questionnaires have been completed, a detailed summary and analysis of the results will be prepared. This analysis will provide a cumulative set of issues and concerns and give weight/importance/priority to issues based on the level of response. This information will be the foundation for community goal setting. A report summarizing the community input will be prepared for review and discussion with the Oversight Committee and made available on the TCD3 website.
