#### SYNOPSIS

A resolution has been prepared authorizing an amendment to the Intergovernmental Agreement for Joint Administration of Employee Health Insurance Program between the Downers Grove Park District and the Village of Downers Grove removing the South East Association for Special Parks and Recreation (SEASPAR) from the Agreement and a resolution has been prepared authorizing an amendment to the Village's Health Plan.

#### RECOMMENDATION

#### **BACKGROUND**

Employees of the Downers Grove Park District and SEASPAR have been included in the Village's group health program since the Village self-funded in 1981. The current intergovernmental agreement states that the Downers Grove Park District and SEASPAR are included in the Village health insurance program and outlines duties and responsibilities of the Village and each of these outside entities. Effective September 1, 2008, SEASPAR, which includes 11 employees, has requested withdrawal from participation in the Village of Downers Grove's health program as it has obtained health insurance coverage through the Park District Risk Management Agency (PDRMA). Representatives from SEASPAR indicated that they were most appreciative of the "excellent coverage and kind service" provided through the Village and that their decision to withdraw from the Village's health program was based solely on budgetary reasons.

The Village's insurance consultant, GCG Financial, has indicated there will be no financial impact to the Village's program because of the relative small size of the departing group. The Downers Grove Park District, which currently includes 54 employees, will remain participants in the Village's group health program. The Village's health program must be amended to reflect this change.

## AMENDMENT TO AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT FOR JOINT ADMINISTRATION OF EMPLOYEE HEALTH INSURANCE PROGRAM BETWEEN THE DOWNERS GROVE PARK DISTRICT AND THE VILLAGE OF DOWNERS GROVE

Based upon a request from the South East Association for Special Parks and Recreation ("SEASPAR") to withdraw from participation in the health insurance program which is the subject of the Agreement The Village of Downers Grove (hereinafter referred to as "Village"), and the Downers Grove Park District (hereinafter referred to as the "Park District") hereby agree to amend An Intergovernmental Agreement For Joint Administration Of Employee Health Insurance Program Between The Downers Grove Park District And The Village Of Downers Grove ("Agreement") dated January 12004 as follows:

- 1. That effective 12:01 a.m. on September 1, 2008, SEASPAR employees shall not be considered Park District employees for purposes of the Agreement and such employees shall not be entitled to participate in the Village employee health insurance plan.

- 3. All other terms and conditions of the Agreement and any other addenda, amendments or extensions thereto shall apply equally to this Amendment.
