SYNOPSIS

A resolution has been prepared to authorize a second amendment to the contract with Christopher B. Burke Engineering, Ltd. (CBBEL) in the amount of \$24,500 for the completion of final design changes requested by the Downers Grove Park District, relative to Watershed Infrastructure Improvement Program (WIIP) project: St. Joseph, North Branch Subwatershed E (SW-042 - Washington Park).

STRATEGIC PLAN ALIGNMENT

The Five Year Plan and Goals for 2008-2013 identified *Top Quality Village Infrastructure and Facilities*. A top priority policy action for this goal is *Watershed Infrastructure Improvement Plan: Funding and Implementation*.

FISCAL IMPACT

The Village entered into an agreement with CBBEL for an amount of \$299,948.26 for the preparation of final engineering plans and construction documents for the Washington Park and Sterling Park Improvements. The total amount budgeted for these two projects was \$400,000 in years 2008 and 2009. This agreement was amended to \$386,728.26 by Village Council action on January 6, 2009. This proposed amendment would bring the contract value to \$411,228.26.

RECOMMENDATION

Approval on the February 3, 2009 consent agenda.

BACKGROUND

On January 22, 2008, the Village entered into a contract with CBBEL for the design of the stormwater improvements to Washington Park and Sterling North Park. At the time the Village entered into this contract, the Village anticipated that it would be designing only stormwater improvements for these projects. On September 2, 2008, the Village entered into Intergovernmental Agreements (IGA's) with the Downers Grove Park District regarding improvements to Washington Park and Sterling North Park. The IGA's state that the Village is responsible for the design and construction of certain recreational improvements with an estimated cost of \$2,050,000 (\$1,300,000 for Washington Park and \$750,000 for Sterling North Park) in addition to the planned stormwater improvements. To meet the obligations of the IGA's, the original contract with CBBEL was amended to require CBBEL to design the recreational improvements. The first amendment to the contract was approved on December 16, 2008. Since that time, staff has been working with the Park District to complete the design of Washington Park. The Park District recently submitted their final review comments on the proposed recreational improvements. Staff did not anticipate receiving these comments. To fulfill the Village's obligations under the IGA, extra design work will be required which has led to the proposed second amendment to the contract. The amount of the second amendment represents approximately 6.5% of the estimated construction value of the additional amenities, which is below the 8-10% rule-of-thumb if these items were to be designed as a stand-alone project.

Approval of this amendment would allow for the timely completion of the design of this project as requested by the Park District. The final Washington Park engineering plans would be completed in early February and bids for construction would be advertised in late February.

SUBJECT: Washington Park Stormwater Storage Basin

Summary of Out of Scope Items (CBBEL Project 08-0013.00002)

The purpose of this memorandum is to summarize the additional items required to complete the 100% design drawings, specifications and bid documents for Washington Park. These items were not included or went beyond the scope that was anticipated in our November 20, 2008 memorandum. The additional items and associated fees are as follows:

- Structural Engineering
 - Additional work for revisions to stairs, washrooms, dugouts and extension of retaining walls - \$9,500
- Civil Engineering
 - Additional work for new layouts of stairs, washrooms, basketball court, bikerack, dugouts and retaining walls - \$3,500
 - Additional work for incorporation of new items into specifications and quantities - \$3,500
- Landscaping
 - Additional landscaping items including 3-foot playground fence, horseshoe pits and plantings above and beyond what was shown on IGA - \$2,500.
- Mechanical Engineering
 - Additional work for revisions to fountain base, fountain lighting, fountain spray, drinking fountains and site lighting - \$5,500

Total Additional Fees for Washington Park: \$24,500

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
