SYNOPSIS

A motion is requested to award a contract for the 2009 Thermo Pavement Marking in the amount not-to-exceed \$30,000 to Superior Road Striping, Inc.

STRATEGIC PLAN ALIGNMENT

The Five Year Plan and Goals for 2008-2013 identified *Exceptional Municipal Organization*. A supporting objective of this goal is *Top Quality Core Services Responsive to Current and Future Community and Citizen Needs*.

FISCAL IMPACT

The FY09 Budget includes \$30,000 in the General Fund for this purchase.

BACKGROUND

Pursuant to the Purchasing Policy, the Village published a call for Bids for this purchase. Bids were received from four (4) vendors that provide this service, which will be in affect from January 1, 2009 through December 31, 2009.

Bids were opened on February 5, 2009. A synopsis of the bids is as follows:

Superior Road Striping, Inc.	\$29,130.00



By signing the bid documents, contractor/proposer/bidder/vendor agrees to refrain from making any campaign contributions as defined in Section 9-1.4 of the Election Code (10 ILCS 5/9-1.4) to any Village Council member and any challengers seeking to serve as a member of the Downers Grove Village Council.

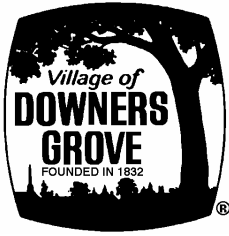
