SYNOPSIS

A motion is requested to award a contract for the Rogers Street Resurfacing Project to C-A Cement, Inc. of Bloomingdale, Illinois in the amount of \$893,130.85.

STRATEGIC PLAN ALIGNMENT

The Five Year Plan and Goals for 2008-2013 identified *Top Quality Village Infrastructure and Facilities*. A high priority policy action for this goal is *Improved Neighborhood Infrastructure Curbs, Gutters, Streets, and Sidewalks*.

FISCAL IMPACT

The approved FY 09 CIP includes a total of \$1,260,000 available for this project, including:

- \$460,000 in the Capital Fund
- \$300,000 in the Water Fund, and
- \$500,000 was set aside from the 2009 Resurfacing Program (ST-004).

RECOMMENDATION

Approval on the July 21, 2009 consent agenda.

BACKGROUND

This project is one of three projects included in the Community Investment Plan for 2009 on Rogers Street. By combining the removal and replacement of the watermain, the installation of a storm sewer and the resurfacing of the roadway Village staff able to accomplish significant cost savings and reduce the frequency of interruption to the neighborhood.

The work for this project will consist of the removal and replacement of curb and gutter and driveway aprons, patching of all utility trenches (i.e. storm sewer & watermain), resurfacing the entire street, as well as parkway restoration. The limits of the project are from Highland Avenue to Maple Avenue. The storm sewer project is complete and the water main replacement will be completed in August 2009. This project is planned to be completed by the end of October 2009.

A total of 5 bids were received on Tuesday, June 30, 2009. A synopsis of the bids is as follows:


