SYNOPSIS

A motion is requested to determine the levy estimate upon the taxable property in the Village in accordance with State law, which requires this action no less than 20 days prior to the adoption of the aggregate levy. In addition, staff requests direction from Council on November 10, 2009 as to the maximum levy to be considered, since this information must be published in the newspaper on November 18, 2009 to be in compliance with State law. The Council will establish the levy on December 15, 2009 and therefore has the opportunity to lower the levy from the levy estimate.

The motion additionally directs staff to prepare ordinances to abate the preliminary tax levies related to the 2009 tax levies.

STRATEGIC PLAN ALIGNMENT

The Five Year Plan and Goals for 2008-2013 identified *Exceptional Municipal Organization* with an objective of *Financially Sound and Sustainable Village Government*.

FISCAL IMPACT

Without the abatement of any debt, the proposed levy is estimated to be \$25,796,756. However, it is recommended that tax levy abatements totaling \$8,426,035, which would abate all Village debt, be approved and therefore, the net taxes to be raised by taxation for 2009 upon the taxable property is \$17,370,271 which includes the levy for the Village and the Public Library. The Village portion of the levy after abatements is estimated to be \$12,477,946. Since there will be opportunity to change the levy between the approval of this motion and the adoption of this levy, there is no fiscal impact at this time.

UPDATE & RECOMMENDATION

This item was discussed at the November 10, 2009 workshop. Staff recommends approval on the November 17, 2009 active agenda, following a discussion of the proposed FY10 municipal budget.

BACKGROUND

The tax levy process requires the adoption of the motion presented in advance of the following:

- Publication of Truth in Taxation Notice and Announcement of Public Hearing 11/18/09
- Public Hearing on Tax Levy 12/01/09
- Adoption of Tax Levy 12/15/09
- Abatement of Certain Debt Levies 12/15/09

Annually, the Village Council is required to levy taxes for the following:

- Village Services defined as corporate/police, fire protection, police pension, fire pension, the total amount of all General Obligation (G.O.) Bond payments due for the fiscal year;
- Library operating, Library debt; and
- all Special Services Areas.

Following the levy of taxes, the Council may *abate* or reduce the levy (reduce the property tax collections) for the specific amount that the Village has other resources available to pay for debt service. The amount to be abated is determined by the budget when specific revenues such as gas tax are identified to pay for the Fairview Avenue debt, water revenues that are identified to pay for bonds issued to improve the water system, revenues from stormwater and capital funds, and revenues from the Tax Increment Financing (TIF) districts that are available and budgeted for debt service.

The Mayor and Village Council have the opportunity to evaluate the proposed tax levy in the context of the budget. In addition, the proposal includes the tax levy and abatements. The amounts proposed for abatement are those debt instruments for which the Village has funds other than property taxes identified to pay principal and interest obligations.

This amount is based upon an estimated levy of \$5,942,486 for corporate and police; \$2,850,000 for fire; \$1,705,508 for police pension; \$1,979,952 for fire pension; \$3,965,265 for library operating; \$656,980 for the 2003 library debt service; \$231,750 for Central Business District 2000 Series debt service; and \$358,412 for Central Business District 2001 Series debt service; and \$513,695 for G.O. Water Issue 2001A debt service; \$346,408 for Central Business District 2002 Series debt service; \$419,000 for Central Business District 2005 Series debt service; and \$711,308 for Fire Station 2 2007 Series debt service; and \$3,997,862 for Stormwater 2008A Series debt service; and \$501,700 for Central Business District 2008 B Series debt service; and \$1,345,900 for Central Business District and Fairview Avenue 2009 Series debt service.</p> |
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The estimated levy for Special Service Area #2, CBD Special Service Area, is \$261,859. The estimated levy for Special Service Area #3, Prince Pond Special Service Area, is \$8,671. A public hearing will be held on these proposed levies on December 8, 2009 at 7:00 p.m. in the Village Council Chambers. The adoption of the proposed levies will be held on December 15, 2009 at 7:00 p.m. in the Village Council Chambers. Staff is also directed to prepare ordinances to abate said 2009 tax levies.

SUMMARY OF ITEM:

Adoption of this motion will estimate the 2009 Village aggregate levy as shown above. This will be the subject of a public hearing on December 8, 2009.
