**SYNOPSIS**

A motion is requested to authorize the award of a contract to Chicagoland Paving Contractors, Inc. of Lake Zurich, Illinois for 2010 pavement patching services in the amount of \$92,650.

**STRATEGIC PLAN ALIGNMENT**

The Five Year Plan and Goals identifies *Top Quality Village Infrastructure and Facilities*.

**FISCAL IMPACT**

The adopted FY10 Water Fund budget provides \$190,000 for street and parkway repairs required due to water utility excavations.

**RECOMMENDATION**

Approval on the April 6, 2010 consent agenda.

**BACKGROUND**

The contract for pavement patching was competitively bid for 2010, with three bids received as summarized below. The contract amount is based on patching approximately 500 square yards of pavement as well as smaller amounts of sidewalk and curb and gutter restoration generated as a result of water utility repairs.

Vian Construction Co., Inc., Elk Grove Village, Illinois	\$188,400

The lowest responsive and responsible bidder is Chicagoland Paving Contractors, Inc. Chicagoland Paving completed this project last year at a similar cost and provided good quality results. They also provided positive references from the Villages of Winnetka, Wilmette and Woodridge, among others. Staff is confident that their work will meet the specifications required by the Village.
