SYNOPSIS

A motion is requested to award a three-year contract for Street Sweeping Maintenance Services to Illinois Central Sweeping LLC of Blue Island, Illinois in the amount of \$318,643.88.

STRATEGIC PLAN ALIGNMENT

The Five Year Plan and Goals identified Top Quality Village Infrastructure and Facilities.

FISCAL IMPACT

The FY10 budget provides a total of \$120,000 for street sweeping services: \$70,000 in the General Fund and \$50,000 in the Stormwater Fund. The proposed street sweeping contract would result in a total charge of \$104,500 for services in FY10.

RECOMMENDATION

Approval on the April 6, 2010 consent agenda.

BACKGROUND

The 2006 Stormwater Master Plan Update identified street sweeping as a key activity for the operation and maintenance of the Village's stormwater system. In fact, street sweeping is recognized as a Best Management Practice (BMP) as part of the National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) requirements that apply to the Village with respect to stormwater. Streets and parking lots accumulate significant amounts of pollutants that contribute to stormwater pollutant runoff to surface waters. Pollutants, including sediment, debris, trash, road salt, and trace metals can be minimized by street sweeping. Street sweeping can also improve the aesthetics of municipal roadways, control dust and decrease the accumulation of pollutants in catch basins.

The level of service expected of potential street sweeping vendors is as follows:

- Routine Street Sweeping: all curbed streets swept six times from mid-April through October
- Downtown Business District: swept 22 times from mid-April through October
- Fall Sweeping: all curbed streets swept three times from mid-October through early December
- Municipal Parking Lots: swept six times from mid-April through October

Unimproved roadways (those without curb and gutter) are not swept as sweepers generally need to work against the edge of a curb to function.

A Request for Proposals (RFP) for street sweeping services was issued and published in February in accordance with the Village's Purchasing Policy. Contractors were asked to provide prices for one year and for three years. The proposals received are summarized in the following tables:

The lowest qualified proposal for both the one-year and three-year options is Illinois Central Sweeping LLC of Blue Island, Illinois. This contract would be their second with Downers Grove (FY06 was their first). Staff is satisfied that Illinois Central Sweeping LLC meets the Village's specifications and that their street sweeping work will be what is required for all three years.

Staff proposes a three-year contract for street sweeping services with Illinois Central Sweeping LLC. FY10 would serve as the first year of the proposed contract and the contract would automatically renew for years two and three. Elgin Sweeping Services, Inc. of Chicago, Illinois completed the Village's street sweeping program in 2009 at a contract price of \$107,934.90.
