### SYNOPSIS

A motion is requested to authorize a change order to an existing contract with Naperville Excavating, Inc. of Naperville, IL, for the McCollum Park Stormwater Improvement Project (SW-034). The amount of the proposed change order, \$10,305.70, would increase the existing contract amount from \$1,270,024.43 to \$1,280,330.13. This is the fourth change order for the McCollum Park Stormwater Project.

### STRATEGIC PLAN ALIGNMENT

The Five Year Plan and Goals for 2008-2013 identified *Top Quality Village Infrastructure and Facilities*. A supporting objective of this goal is *Improve Neighborhood Infrastructure Curbs*, *Gutters*, *Streets*, *Sidewalks*, *Stormwater and Drainage System*.

### **FISCAL IMPACT**

The FY09 budget included \$1,250,000 in the Stormwater Improvement Fund for this project, SW-034. There was a total of \$2,750,000 from the stormwater bond proceeds allocated for Prentiss Creek Subwatershed B, of which approximately \$2,570,000 will have been spent for the 2008 Fairmount Storm Sewer and this project.

### RECOMMENDATION

Approval on the June 1, 2010 consent agenda.

### **BACKGROUND**

On April 7, 2009, the Village Council awarded a contract to Naperville Excavating, Inc. of Naperville, IL, for the McCollum Park Stormwater Improvement Project (SW-034). The contract was to provide stormwater detention in the form of a detention facility located at the northwest section of the Park District-owned property, McCollum Park. This detention facility, in conjunction with other projects, will alleviate drainage issues along Fairmount Ave from 61<sup>st</sup> Street to 67<sup>th</sup> Street and along 67<sup>th</sup> Street west of Blackstone Drive. Storage gained with the proposed detention basin will allow water to drain more efficiently from upstream areas and reduce flooding elevations. The project also includes constructing park amenities, including new basketball courts, volleyball courts, and construction of a new soccer field with underdrain and irrigation systems.

This is the fourth change order for the McCollum Park Stormwater Improvement Project. The first change order was approved by Village Council on June 30, 2009 for an amount of \$27,123.00. The second change order was approved by Village Council on November 3, 2009 for an amount of \$23,705.91. The third change order was approved by Village Council on December 15, 2009 for an amount of \$43,892.24. This change order would increase the existing contract amount from \$1,270,024.43 to \$1,280,330.13. The proposed change order includes additional work to correct a design oversight. The underdrain system is currently in conflict with Downers Grove Park District field maintenance procedures (deep tine aeration). The conflict will be eliminated by replacing sections of the field above the underdrain system with an appropriate drainage medium (amended soil).

Resolving the conflict will include the following item:

• Placement of Sand Above Underdrain System

### Project status and completed work

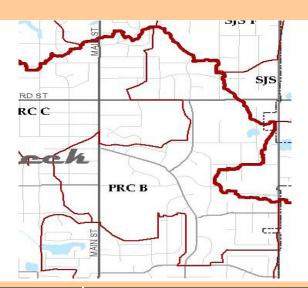
