SYNOPSIS

Ordinances been prepared amending the Liquor Code which would:

- *Allow on-site consumption of alcoholic liquor at a video gaming facility;
- *Amend the definition of recreational facilities in the Liquor Code to allow on-site consumption of beer and wine at an Indoor Simulated Golf Facility;
 - *Amend Sunday hours for the on-premise consumption of liquor.

UPDATE & RECOMMENDATION

This item was discussed at the October 5, 2010 Village Council meeting. Staff recommends approval on the October 12, 2010 active agenda.

BACKGROUND

Based upon a request, the Downers Grove Liquor Commission discussed creating a liquor license classification which would allow the consumption of alcoholic liquor at a video gaming facility. Currently, the Village does not have a license classification which would allow on-site consumption for premises where the primary business is where the public may participate for a fee in organized, competitive video gaming, online and through the use of video gaming consoles (i.e. Wii, XBox, PlayStation). Food service will be available at all times, however restaurant activities would not be the primary business of the establishment. The bar/lounge area will be limited to 20% of the total seating available in the establishment.

The Downers Grove Liquor Commission discussed another request to allow the consumption of beer and wine at an Indoor Simulated Golf Facility. Currently, the Village allows beer and wine consumption at certain recreational facilities which are sport oriented. Staff proposed amending the recreational facility definition to include indoor simulated golf as it is in line with the nature of the classification where activities such as volleyball, tennis, racquetball or handball clubs, bowling, pool are the primary business of the establishment. Limited food service will be available, however, restaurant activities would be ancillary to the primary business. The bar/lounge area will be limited to 20% of the total seating available.

The Municipal Code was amended in February of 2009 to allow the sale of alcoholic liquor for off-premise consumption to begin at 9:00 a.m. on Sundays. Currently, alcoholic liquor cannot be sold prior to 12 noon on Sundays at on-premise licensed establishments. A number of surrounding communities have amended Sunday liquor sales hours for on-premise license holders, including Westmont (9:00 a.m.), Lisle (10:00 a.m.), Woodridge (6:00 a.m.) and Darien (9:00 a.m.) and most recently, Naperville (8:00 am.).

In an effort to remain competitive with our surrounding communities, staff presented a draft ordinance to the Liquor Commission to allow on-premised licensees to be able to offer liquor on Sundays beginning at 9:00 a.m. All other liquor sale hours will remain unchanged. (Monday through Friday 8:00 a.m. – 1:00 a.m. and Saturday 8:00 a.m. through 2:00 a.m.)

The Liquor Commission discussed these matters at their meeting of September 9, 2010 and unanimously recommended that the ordinances be forwarded to the Council for their consideration and approval.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING RECREATIONAL FACILITY LICENSE CLASSIFICATIONS
BE IT ORDAINED by the Village Council of the Village of Downers Grove in DuPage County,
Illinois, as follows: (Additions are indicated by shading/underline; deletions by strikeout):
Section 1. That Section 3.3 is hereby amended to read as follows:
3.3 Definitions.For the purposes of this Chapter, the following words and phrases shall have the meanings respectively ascribed to them by this section:* * *
Recreational facility. A place in which the public may participate in a sport or engage in activities, including but not limited to volleyball, tennis, racquetball or handball clubs; bowling alleys, pool halls, indoor simulated golf facilities, and health clubs. Provided, such facilities shall include an area in which service of food prepared on premises is provided, including hot or cold sandwiches or other similar foods. * * *
Section 2. That Section 3.15. is hereby amended to read as follows:
3.15. Limitation on number of licenses. The number of licenses in each classification as defined in Section 3-13 which it shall be lawful to issue shall be limited so that the licenses in force and effect at any time shall not exceed the following numbers:
License Classification Amount of licenses not to Exceed
* * * * "E-3-B" (Recreational Facility - beer/wine) * * *
<u>Section 3</u> . That all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are
hereby repealed.
Section 4. That this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication
in the manner provided by law.
