#### **SYNOPSIS**

An ordinance has been prepared to amend the Municipal Code concerning No Turn on Red modifications at the intersection of 39<sup>th</sup> Street and Highland Avenue in the vicinity of Highland Grade School.

#### RECOMMENDATION

Approval on the May 17, 2011 active agenda.

#### **BACKGROUND**

The intersection of 39<sup>th</sup> Street and Highland Avenue is located in proximity to Highland School. The intersection is staffed by a crossing guard and has a 'No Turn on Red When Children are Present' restriction. At the request of the crossing guard at this location, who noticed that motorists fail to yield the right-of-way to pedestrians, the Police and Public Works Departments reviewed the operation of this intersection. Based on observations, staff agrees there is a need to make the turn restrictions more specific and enforceable during the times when school children are crossing.

Staff recommends new restrictions of "No Turn On Red 8-9 AM and 2-3 PM" for all legs of this intersection as well as the installation of the corresponding signs. Because Highland School is not visible from this intersection, this signage will remind motorists of the presence of pedestrians and the need to exercise more caution during the times of peak pedestrian use. With the proposed change in turn restrictions, staff also proposes concurrent Police enforcement for an initial period after the new signs are installed.

This item was presented at the March 9, 2011 Transportation and Parking Commission meeting. The Commission voted unanimously to approve the modified restrictions.

#### AN ORDINANCE REGULATING TURNS AT 39TH & HIGHLAND

BE IT ORDAINED by the Village Council of the Village of Downers Grove in DuPage County, Illinois, as follows: (Additions are indicated by shading/underline; deletions by strikeout):

#### Section 1. That Section 14.8. is hereby amended to read as follows:

#### 14.8. "No turn on red" intersections.

(a) On the basis of traffic investigations at the below named intersections, it is found that traffic conditions do not safely allow turns on a red light and that the following intersections should be designated as "No turn on red" intersections:

Fairview Avenue and Lincoln Street, north and south approaches only.

Main Street and Burlington Avenue.

Main Street and Curtiss Street.

Main Street and Grant Street.

Maple Avenue and Main Street.

39th Street and Fairview Avenue, west approach only.

(b) On the basis of traffic investigations at the below named intersections, it is found that traffic conditions do not safely allow turns on a red light and that vehicles facing a steady red signal shall be prohibited from turning right after stopping at all times when pedestrians are present in the vicinity of the following intersections:

Belmont Road and Prairie Avenue, east approach only.

Fairview Avenue and Hill Street, south approach only.

Fairview Avenue and Prairie Avenue, north approach only.

Maple Avenue and Main Street.

(c) On the basis of traffic investigations at the below named intersections, it is found that traffic conditions do not safely allow turns on a red light and that the following intersections should be designated "No Turn On Red" intersections, with the hourly restrictions of 8:00-9:00 AM and 2:00-3:00 PM:

39th Street at Highland Avenue, all approaches.
