SYNOPSIS

A resolution has been prepared authorizing the Village to enter into a three-year agreement with a two-year option to renew with the American Legion Post #80 to hold the annual Memorial Day Parade.

STRATEGIC PLAN ALIGNMENT

The Strategic Goals for 2011-2018 included *Exceptional Municipal Services*.

FISCAL IMPACT

Under the terms of the agreement, the Village would responsible for costs incurred by the Village and the Legion would not be charged any fees for this event. Staff estimates that the cost of supporting this parade would be approximately \$700 per year.

RECOMMENDATION

Staff recommends action at the discretion of the Village Council. This item can be placed on the April 17, 2012 active agenda.

BACKGROUND

American Legion Post #80, located in Downers Grove, has operated Memorial Day Parades for many years. In 2011, the American Legion did not conduct the parade, due in part to the fees of approximately \$700 that would have been charged to cover the cost of Village provided support services pursuant to the Village's community events policy approved by the Council in 2010.

The American Legion recently submitted an application for a temporary use permit to conduct the 2012 Memorial Day Parade. The parade would begin at 11:00 am and run along Main Street from Burlington Avenue to Grove Street. A site plan is attached. During a pre-application meeting with Village staff, the American Legion requested that the fees for the parade be waived. Two members of the Village Council contacted the Village Manager and requested that American Legion's request for a fee waiver be placed on a Council meeting agenda for review and consideration. Three options have been identified to address the American Legion's request.

Option 1: Enter into an Agreement with the American Legion – Under this option, the Village would enter into an agreement with the American Legion (attached). The agreement would state that:

- o The Village values the Legion's Memorial Day Parade and desires that such a parade be held annually
- o The Legion shall be required to operate Memorial Day Parades in 2012, 2013 and 2014 and may be required to operate the parade in 2015 and 2016 if the agreement is extended.
- The Legion shall apply for and obtain a temporary use permit and operate the parades in accordance with Village Codes and terms and conditions of the agreement.

- o The Village will not charge the Legion any fees for the operation of the parades.
- o The Village Manager may make change, suspend or revoke the agreement.

Option 2: Amend the Community Event Fee Policy to Exempt Celebratory and Ceremonial Events Operated by Federally Chartered or Accredited Veterans Organizations from Village Fees – Under this option, the Village would amend the event fee policy approved in 2010 to exempt from payment of fees for Village services provided in support of the event. Temporary Use permits would still be required to allow the Village to determine the type and amount of Village services that would be provided in support of the event and to regulate the event using conditions of approval.

Option 3: Waive the Fees for the 2012 Memorial Day Parade and Direct Staff and the Community Events Commission to Consider Amendments to the Community Event Fee Policy – Under this option, the Village fees for support services for the 2012 parade would be waived. In addition, staff and the Community Events Commission would consider amendments to the community event fee policy as directed by the Council. The amendments for consideration could include the exemption of celebratory and ceremonial events as noted above in Option 2.

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING EXECUTION OF A LICENSE AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE VILLAGE OF DOWNERS GROVE AND AMERICAN LEGION POST #80

BE IT RESOLVED by the Village Council of the Village of Downers Grove, DuPage County, Illinois, as follows:

- 1. That the form and substance of a certain License Agreement (the "Agreement"), between the Village of Downers Grove (the "Village") and American Legion Post #80 (the "Legion"), for organizing and conducting an annual Memorial Day Parade, as set forth in the form of the Agreement submitted to this meeting with the recommendation of the Village Manager, is hereby approved.
- 2. That the Village Manager and Village Clerk are hereby respectively authorized and directed for and on behalf of the Village to execute, attest, seal and deliver the Agreement, substantially in the form approved in the foregoing paragraph of this Resolution, together with such changes as the Manager shall deem necessary.
- 3. That the proper officials, agents and employees of the Village are hereby authorized and directed to take such further action as they may deem necessary or appropriate to perform all obligations and commitments of the Village in accordance with the provisions of the Agreement.
- 4. That all resolutions or parts of resolutions in conflict with the provisions of this Resolution are hereby repealed.
- 5. That this Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage as provided by law.

LICENSE AGREEMENT

THIS LICENSE AGREEMENT, is made and entered into this _____ day of April, 2012, by and between the Village of Downers Grove (the "Village") and American Legion Post #80 (the "Legion") for the purpose of organizing and conducting an annual Memorial Day Parade,

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, the Legion has traditionally organized and put on a Memorial Day Parade in the Village for more than 90 years to honor fallen soldiers; and

WHEREAS, the Legion was unable to have the Memorial Day Parade in 2011 due to the costs; and

WHEREAS, the Village values such a parade as a community event in order to commemorate our nation's service members; and

WHEREAS, the Village desires that a Memorial Day Parade be held annually and desires that the Legion organize and put on said Parade annually which the Legion has agreed to do;

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants, conditions and agreements herein set forth, and other good and valuable consideration, the parties hereto agree as follows:

- 1. The provisions of the preamble are hereby incorporated into and made a part of this Agreement.
- 2. The term of this Agreement shall be for three (3) years (for the parades for 2012, 2013 and 2014) with an option to extend for an additional two (2) years (2015 and 2016).
- 3. The Legion shall be required to submit an application and any other required documentation in order to obtain a parade permit from the Village each year. However, there will be no costs or fees for said permit.
- 4. The Parade shall take place on Memorial Day each year between 9:00 a.m. and 12:00 p.m.
- 5. Each year the Legion shall submit to the Village a map depicting the proposed parade route and request closure of said street(s).
- 6. The Village hereby grants unto the Legion a revocable license for the use of Village streets for an annual Memorial Day Parade.
- 4. In conducting the Parade for the Village, the Legion shall abide by the following each year:
 - 4.1. The Parade shall comply with the provisions of the Downers Grove Municipal Code, including but not limited to, Sections 4-201 through 4-211.
 - 4.2. The Parade shall be established and operated in a safe and reasonable manner with due regard for the health and safety of persons and property.
 - 4.3. The Parade shall be operated in a clean, well maintained and sanitary manner.
 - 4.4. No License Fee will be required.

- 4.5. To the fullest extent permitted by law, the Legion shall defend, indemnify and hold harmless the Village, and its officers, boards, commissions, elected and appointed officials, agents and employees, for any and all claims from any loss, claim, occurrence or liability whatsoever which may be incurred or arise out of this Agreement or the Parade. In addition, all third parties participating in the Parade shall be required to completely release and hold harmless the Village of Downers Grove, its officers, agents and employees from any loss, claim, occurrence or liability whatsoever which may be incurred or arise out of this Agreement or the Parade.
- 4.6. This Agreement shall not be transferable or assignable and shall not confer any property rights in the underlying right-of-way.
- 4.7. This Agreement shall be subject to the absolute and primary right of the Village to protect the public health safety and welfare. The Village Manager may, in the Manager's sole discretion, order changes to the conduct of the Parade, including but not limited to the immediate cessation of business, and removal of any or all equipment and facilities from the public right of way. In addition, the Village Manager may suspend or revoke any license issued under this Section in the event it is determined that the Legion has failed or refused to comply with the regulations of this Section, the license agreement or with other applicable law.
- 5. Each year the Village shall take all necessary action and use its personnel to close whichever streets will be used for the Parade at no cost to the Legion. The Village shall also provide any additional services through its personnel (Fire Department, Police Department, Public Works Department) as may be necessary throughout the set-up, duration and break down of the Parade at no cost to the Legion.
