Valley View Pond - Staff has provided responses to resident and Council questions that were asked at the June 19 Village Council meeting. Staff e-mailed the interested residents to let them know that the responses have been posted. This item is scheduled to appear on the July 17 Village Council meeting on the First Reading agenda.

Carpenter Street Resurfacing to Begin Next Week

Work is scheduled to begin next week on the resurfacing of Carpenter Street between Maple Avenue and Gilbert Avenue. This project consists of the grinding off the existing surface, patching the pavement base, spot curb repair and resurfacing. The work is anticipated to be completed by August 17, 2012. The Village was awarded a grant under the Surface Transportation Program (STP) in the amount of \$97,200 to assist with this project. Changeable message boards have been posted in advance of the start of the project to alert motorists and the street will remain open to traffic during construction.

ONGOING PROJECTS

Belmont Underpass

Work during Previous Week

- The pedestrian tunnel was open for use on Thursday, replacing the at-grade pedestrian rail crossing. To further enhance safety, inter-rail fencing was installed at this location to preclude pedestrians from crossing the tracks.
- The stairways connecting Belmont Road to the rail platforms at the underpass have been opened for use.
- The paving and striping of all the off-street commuter parking lots were complete and they are open for parking. The temporary over-flow parking lot on Chase was closed.

- Work continues on the new and replacement traffic signals at Haddow and Prairie.
- Landscaping of the disturbed areas continues throughout the project.

Planned Work

- Open Burlington/Warren and the northeast ramp to traffic by 7/13
- Complete fabrication and installation of all safety railings
- Complete the traffic signals at Haddow and Prairie by mid to late August
- Open Belmont Road to four lanes of traffic with temporary striping after signals are complete
- Complete landscape restoration (place sod) starting September 1st
- Install final asphalt surface course and striping after landscaping is complete
- Open Belmont to four lanes of traffic with final surface and striping
- Percent Complete: 92%

2012 Roadway Maintenance Program, Street Resurfacing (A) Phase 1

Awarded Amount: \$2,071,188.10 Contract Completion Date: 8/3/12

Contract Completion Date For Sod: 9/15/12

Work Performed This Week:

- Parkway restoration preparation in the Deer Creek and Downers Drive/Almond Court areas.
- Surface milling operations completed on 56th Court, Powell and Lincoln.
- Base patching operations ongoing in the Valley View area.
- Pavement saw cuts ongoing in the Deer Creek area in advance of base patching.

Work Anticipated Next Week:

- Parkway restoration preparation may continue in the Downers Drive area.
- Base patching operations should be completed in Valley View area by 7/6.
- Base patching operations will progress in the Deer Creek, Powell, Lincoln and the Downers Drive areas.
- The first course of asphalt paving in the Valley View and Deer Creek areas.
- Surface milling operations may begin in the Downers Drive/Almond Court and Red Bud/Red Silver areas.
- Concrete curb and sidewalk repairs are scheduled to continue in the Snowberry area and on Downers
 Drive near Snowberry
- Percent Complete 50%

Awarded Amount: \$1,734,912.38 Estimated Start of Work: August 2012 Contract Completion Date: 11/16/12

2012 Preventive Seal & Parking Lot Improvements

Awarded Amount: \$298,539.74

Contract Completion Date: July 29, 2012

All contract quantity rubber and fiber crack seal work is completed.

In the next few weeks the contractor is scheduled to crack seal, seal coat & apply new pavement markings for the parking lots at the Village Hall, Police Department Fairview Avenue Commuter Station.

Valley View Estates Reconstruction and Water Main Replacement

Awarded Amount: \$3,552,453.00

Contract Completion Date: November 16, 2012

Work Performed This Week:

The contractor completed curb replacement on a small portion of 71st Street. The contractor started grading parkways on Waterfall, Valley View, Foster and Hobart and general cleanup of the jobsite before starting pavement removal next week.

Work Anticipated Next Week:

Next week the contractor is scheduled to start pavement removal on Waterfall, Valley View, Hobart, and Foster. The contractor will be removing the pavement and placing stone base at the same time. Residents will not have access to their driveways or streets during the day but will have access at the end of the work day.

Percent Complete: 36%

Knottingham Reconstruction and Water Main Replacement

Awarded Amount: \$5,489,847.76

Contract Completion Date: November 16, 2012

Percent Complete: 34% Work Performed This Week:

The contractor continued the reconstruction of Knottingham between Plainfield and 77th Street and the reconstruction of Marie Drive between Knottingham and Baimbridge. The pavement was removed, the aggregate sub-base was installed and the curbs and gutters were installed. The residents were notified they would not have access to their driveways for 7 to 10 days. The contractor also capped the Darien water mains at Knottingham and 75th and Plainfield.

Work Anticipated Next Week:

Next week the contractor will continue the reconstruction of Knottingham and Marie by backfilling the curbs, installing driveways and placing asphalt binder course.

Percent Complete: 34%

Washington Street Resurfacing, Burlington to Maple

Improvements will include street resurfacing, intermittent curb and gutter replacement, intermittent storm sewer replacement, curb ramp upgrades and redesigned pavement markings.

Project was bid on June 13, 2012. Bid opening was held on June 27, 2012.

Two bids were received and are being evaluated.

Curb removal and replacement and pavement base patching. Traffic will be maintained with signage and
