SYNOPSIS

A motion is requested for the purchase of bulk road salt from Cargill Incorporated Salt Division of North Olmsted, Ohio for snow and ice control via the State Contract at a cost of \$63.24 per ton and a total not to exceed cost of \$318,729.60. The price of \$63.24 per ton is the same price the Village has paid for salt since the 09/10 snow season.

STRATEGIC PLAN ALIGNMENT

The Goals for 2011 to 2018 include Exceptional Municipal Services.

FISCAL IMPACT

Approval of this motion obligates the Village to purchase the minimum quantity specified at a cost of \$212,486. The FY12 Adopted Budget and FY13 Requested Budget in the General Fund include funding for the purchase of road salt for the winter of 2012/13.

UPDATE & RECOMMENDATION

This item was discussed at the September 18, 2012 Village Council meeting. Staff recommends approval on the October 2, 2012 Consent Agenda.

BACKGROUND

Prior to each snow season, the Village enters into a contract for the purchase of road salt at a unit price, which impacts two fiscal years and specifies a minimum and maximum quantity of salt allowable for purchase. According to the terms of the contract, the Village can purchase as little as 3,360 tons of salt at a total cost of \$212,486 or as much as 5,040 tons of salt at a cost of \$318,730. The Public Works Department has an inventory of 2,500 tons of salt from last winter.

In completing the CY 2012 – 2013 Rock Salt season contract re-procurement, the State of Illinois did not encounter any supply-related issues experienced in previous seasons. We make every effort to secure road salt at the best available price for each participant in our contract re-procurement, and gladly report that all participating locations will have their supply needs met through the State's procurement efforts.

In accordance with your response on "Table B: Complete to have the State RENEW for your governmental entity" from the seasonal participation survey, we have secured your revised REQUISITION QUANTITY with the previous season's contract vendor.

Warehouses are open Monday through Friday, 7:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. Please contact the vendor during regular business hours for the specific warehouse location in your area.

The additional price per ton to have rock salt delivered in trucks equipped with coal/grain chute openings in the tailgate to permit controlled off-loading of rock salt onto conveyors is \$20.00 per ton. Contact vendor for availability in your area and scheduling deliveries.

You are responsible for issuing your own purchase order document to the vendor. Orders may be placed with the vendor via telephone, with a written or fax confirmation to follow immediately. You are strongly encouraged to order early and to store as much salt as possible in order to help prevent potential salt shortages this winter. Also, you need to make every effort to place orders in full truckload lots (22-25 tons) or multiples of such.

Deliveries of rock salt containing any foreign material such as mud, rocks, grader teeth, wood, tarpaulins, etc., may be rejected at the delivery site. In the event that any foreign material is discovered in dumped deliveries, the salt and foreign matter may be reloaded onto the cartage hauler's truck by the local governmental unit and returned for credit, or the vendor shall immediately ship a specification compliant load of replacement salt, or issue a refund to the governmental unit consistent with the contract price.

In December 2012, the contract vendor shall have in place stockpile(s) located in or near Illinois covering the tonnage awarded for the northern regions of the State, and in January of 2013 the contract vendor shall have in place stockpile(s) in or near to Illinois covering the total tonnage awarded for all regions of the State. At our discretion, we will inspect the stockpiles to ensure that these stockpiles are in sufficient quantities, and that vendor commitments to the stockpiles are with the users of this contract.

Enhanced rock salt 2012 - 2013 season availability from Cargill Inc. Deicing:

The enhanced salt product features additional pre-treatment of approved road salt with a product providing enhanced melting performance, with reduced corrosion and clumping.

The Department of Central Management Services requested pricing for an enhanced rock salt option in the invitation for bid, and received an offering from Cargill's' Deicing Unit. Their prices are made available to any joint purchasing participant awarded in the Cargill Rock Salt Contract as an up-charge per ton option and are to be added to your order as a separate line item. Locations interested in ordering this enhanced salt option must call the vendor to facilitate ordering arrangements.
