**Belmont and Curtiss Intersection Improvements -** DuPage County is improving the intersection at Belmont and Curtiss, which will include adding left turn lanes and new traffic signals. The project involves widening the bridge over St. Joseph's Creek as well as significant utility relocations. This week, Curtiss Street was closed to traffic at Belmont Road in order to install a new storm sewer across Curtiss and the County has encountered unexpected field conditions during this work. Village staff continues to work with the County to facilitate traffic and coordinate with the watermain replacement work the Village has contracted on Curtiss.

## STREET MAINTENANCE 2012 Roadway Maintenance Program, Street Resurfacing (A) Phase 1

Awarded Amount: \$2,071,188.10 Contract Completion Date: 8/3/12 Contract Completion Date for Sod: 9/15/12 <u>Work Performed This Week:</u> Additional parkway preparation work. The majority of sod placement is complete in the Deer Creek area.

#### Work Anticipated Next Week:

Sod placement should be completed in the Deer Creek, Powell, Lincoln and the Downers Dr to Red Bud areas 10/5, 10/6 or early week of 10/8.

## 2012 Roadway Maintenance Program, Street Resurfacing (B) Phase 2

Awarded Amount: \$1,734,912.38 Contract Completion Date: 11/16/12 Work Performed This Week:

Concrete curb and sidewalk repair work was completed throughout the Montgomery, Seeley, Wallbank area, the Cumnor, Grant, Sheldon area and the Palmer / Powell area. The majority of the concrete curb and sidewalk repair work was completed in the 68<sup>th</sup> St/Carpenter and Concord areas. Base patching operations were completed throughout the Cumnor/Grant area. The first course of new asphalt paving was substantially complete on Grant/Traube. Asphalt drive repairs started throughout the project.

## Work Anticipated Next Week:

Remaining minor concrete sidewalk and drive repair work should be completed in the 68<sup>th</sup> St and Concord areas. The first course of new asphalt paving should be completed on Grant, Cumnor, Florence, Sheldon, Prairie and Otis and manhole frame adjustments in the pavement will follow the paving. Surface milling operations should begin in the Stonewall/Cornell and Montgomery to Wallbank areas. Milling operations may also progress to the Palmer / Powell area. Base patching operations will follow surface milling. Asphalt driveway repairs may be completed throughout the project next week. Parkway restoration preparation may begin next week in the Cumnor/Grant and the Montgomery to Wallbank areas.

#### Valley View Estates Reconstruction and Water Main Replacement

Awarded Amount: \$3,552,453.00 Contract Completion Date: November 16, 2012 <u>Work Performed This Week:</u> The contractor completed earth excavation and started the installation of the stone base for the new streets on Robey and Parker. <u>Work Anticipated Next Week:</u>

The contractor is scheduled to complete stone base and asphalt binder course installation on Robey and Parker.

## **Knottingham Reconstruction and Water Main Replacement**

Awarded Amount: \$5,489,847.76 Contract Completion Date: November 16, 2012 Work Performed This Week: The contractor completed the installation of driveways and sidewalk on south Rohrer Drive and began the installation of pavement. The contractor will begin the installation of new curb and gutter along north Queens Court.

Work Anticipated Next Week:

The contractor will begin the installation of driveways and pavement along north Queens Court. The contractor may begin the pavement removal along south Queens Court.

## WATER IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS

#### Maple Avenue Water Tower Repainting Project

Awarded Amount: \$954,210 Contract Completion Date: November 26, 2012 Work Performed This Week:

- Interior sand blasting and priming of the bowl.
- Began exterior sand blasting.

Work Anticipated Next Week:

- Continue interior sand blasting and priming of bowl.
- Continue exterior sand blasting and priming.

As of September 28 interior dry surfaces (column) were 70% cleaned and primed and interior wet surfaces were 20% cleaned and primed. Repair work (welding) was 70% complete. Completion of this project was delayed as a result of the unprecedented drought and higher than average daily water use.

#### 2012 Water Main Improvements – Contract B

Awarded Amount: \$1,312,022.56 Extended Contract Completion Date: October 5<sup>th</sup> <u>Work Performed This Week:</u>

Water service connections were begun for the Curtiss Street water main between Katrine Avenue & St. Joseph Creek. Continued installation of water main on Curtiss Street between Chase Avenue and St. Joseph Creek and at Belmont Road & the Curtiss Street intersection. Backfilled auger pits on the east and west sides of St. Joseph Creek. The new 8" water main on Curtiss Street between Belmont Road and St. Joseph Creek is expected to be complete and ready for testing by Oct. 5<sup>th</sup>. Concrete, asphalt milling, patching, and HMA Level Binder operations are complete on Florence Avenue and Cumnor Road. Blodgett Avenue is to be done when Florence Avenue and Cumnor Road are ready for final lift of HMA Surface Course. Parkway restoration (black dirt only) work is complete for Cumnor Road and Florence Avenue. Parkway restoration for Blodgett Avenue will occur after milling, patching, and HMA Level Binder operations are complete.

#### Work Anticipated Next Week:

Next week the water service connections to businesses will continue on Curtiss Street between Katrine Avenue and St. Joseph Creek. Final asphalt paving operations may start on Cumnor Road and Florence Avenue contingent upon manhole adjustments being done. The new 8" water main on Curtiss Street between Belmont Road and St. Joseph Creek will be pressure tested and chlorinated.

## Prentiss Creek (Sub E) – Kensington Place

The contractor continues to coordinate with the Illinois Department of Natural Resources for a determination on the permitting requirements for future improvements to the weir structure.

Work Anticipated Next Week:

Begin design after determination of the weir structure by the Illinois Department of Natural Resources. Staff is coordinating with the contractor to schedule a public meeting for design comments in late September.

# Lacey Creek (Sub G) Stormwater Improvements - 35<sup>th</sup> St between Saratoga and Venard

Final plans and specifications have been delivered. Regional permit approved by Army Corp of Engineers and Kane DuPage Soil and Water Conservation District. Village still needs to approve stormwater permit. Project will be constructed in spring 2013.

Percent Complete: 5%
