## **SYNOPSIS**

A motion is requested to determine the levy estimate upon the taxable property in the Village in accordance with State law, which requires this action no less than 20 days prior to the adoption of the aggregate levy. In addition, staff requests direction from Council on November 6, 2012 as to the maximum levy to be considered, since this information must be published in the newspaper on November 21, 2012 to be in compliance with State law. The Council will establish the levy on December 11, 2012.

The motion additionally directs staff to prepare ordinances to abate the preliminary tax levies related to the 2012 tax levies.

#### STRATEGIC PLAN ALIGNMENT

The goals for 2011-2018 include Steward of Fiscal and Environmental Sustainability.

## **FISCAL IMPACT**

Without the abatement of any debt, the proposed levy is estimated to be \$24,861,922. However, it is recommended that tax levy abatements totaling \$8,638,064, which would abate all Village debt, be approved and therefore, the net taxes to be raised by taxation for 2012 upon the taxable property is \$16,223,858 which includes the levy for the Village, Special Service Areas and the Public Library. The Village portion of the levy after abatements is estimated to be \$11,006,701. Since there will be opportunity to change the levy between the approval of this motion and the adoption of this levy, there is no fiscal impact at this time.

### RECOMMENDATION

Staff recommends approval on the November 13, 2012 active agenda.

## **BACKGROUND**

The tax levy process requires the adoption of the motion presented in advance of the following:

•	Publication of Truth in Taxation Notice and Announcement of Public Hearing	11/21/12
•	Public Hearing on Tax Levy	12/04/12
•	Adoption of Tax Levy	12/11/12
•	Abatement of Certain Debt Levies	12/11/12

Annually, the Village Council is required to levy taxes for the following:

- Village Services defined as corporate/police, fire protection, police pension, fire pension, the total amount of all General Obligation (G.O.) Bond payments due for the fiscal year;
- Library operating, Library debt; and
- all Special Services Areas.

Following the levy of taxes, the Council may *abate* or reduce the levy (reduce the property tax collections) for the specific amount that the Village has other resources available to pay for debt service. The amount

to be abated is determined by the budget when specific revenues such as gas tax are identified to pay for the Fairview Avenue debt, water revenues that are identified to pay for bonds issued to improve the water system, revenues from stormwater and capital funds, and revenues from the Tax Increment Financing (TIF) districts that are available and budgeted for debt service.

The Mayor and Village Council have the opportunity to evaluate the proposed tax levy in the context of the budget. In addition, the proposal includes the tax levy and abatements. The amounts proposed for abatement are those debt instruments for which the Village has funds other than property taxes identified to pay principal and interest obligations.
