Tree Removal Update - An increased number of Village-owned ash trees have been identified for removal, including several along Maple Avenue near the downtown. Last year, staff removed 212 Ash trees and to date there are 226 marked for removal for 2013. Staff anticipates removing a total of approximately 300 ash trees this year. This increase is attributed to a faster rate of decline in the trees that weren't treated for Emerald Ash Borer (EAB) as well as last year's drought, which reduced the effectiveness the EAB treatment on some trees.

**DuPage County to Resurface Main Street** - Work on Main Street is scheduled to start the week of July 8th and continue until the end of August. The work will be along Main Street from 63rd to just south of Robey Avenue and will consist of intermittent curb removal and replacement and grinding and resurfacing of the road. The project is a DuPage County project.
