C. Resolution: Authorize an Amendment to the Resolution Authorizing Certain Purchases for FY2013 from the Suburban Tree Consortium

How much money has the Village spent on EAB treatments?

Since 2008, the Village has spent a total of \$159,425 on EAB treatments.

Does the value of a tree increase with the size and age of a tree? If so, can this be quantified?

The value of a tree increases with tree diameter provided the condition of the tree is good. Staff uses the appraisal formula of the International Society of Arboriculture to determine value. Additional details are in Chapter 8 of the Urban Forestry Program manual, found here:

Were the wellness testing expenses included in the budget?

The wellness testing is not included as a line item, as it is paid out through the contract with Blue Cross/Blue Shield. The cost of this agreement is included in the overall administrative and claims budget in the Health Insurance Fund.
