#### SYNOPSIS

An ordinance has been prepared to amend a section of the Municipal Code for a 2-Hour Parking restriction, along the east side of Washington Street, between Maple Avenue and Curtiss Street.

#### **UPDATE & RECOMMENDATION**

This item was discussed at the December 10, 2013 Village Council meeting. Staff recommends approval on the December 17, 2013 Active Agenda.

#### BACKGROUND

This item is being presented in response to a recent construction project along Washington Street, between Maple Avenue and the BNSF Railroad tracks which resulted in the re-configuration of the parking restrictions along the east side of Washington Street and the addition of three parking spaces. In order to be consistent with the surrounding parking restrictions, staff recommends placing a "Two-Hour Parking" restriction on the new spaces. The previous parking restriction for this area (north of Maple Ave to south of Curtiss Street) was "No Parking Any Time."

This item was presented to the Transportation and Parking Commission on October 9, 2013. The Commission voted unanimously to approve this action as presented.

### AN ORDINANCE AMENDING PARKING RESTRICTIONS ON WASHINGTON FROM MAPLE TO CURTISS

BE IT ORDAINED by the Village Council of the Village of Downers Grove in DuPage County,

Illinois, as follows: (Additions are indicated by shading/underline; deletions by strikeout):

### Section 1. That Section 14.98 is hereby amended to read as follows:

### 14.98 No parking zones-Generally.

No person shall park or let stand, any automobile, motor vehicle or other vehicle at any time in any of the following locations:

Washington Street, on the east side, from a point one hundred thirty feet south of the south line of Curtiss Street to a point four hundred sixty five feet south of the south line of Curtiss Street.

#### Section 2. That Section 14.105.07. is hereby amended to read as follows:

### 14.105.07. Same--Between 6:00 A.M. and 6:00 P.M., except on Sundays and holidays. (2-Hour Parking)

Except on Sundays and holidays, no person shall park, stop or let stand any automobile, motor vehicle or other vehicle for more than two consecutive hours at any time between the hours of 6:00 A.M. and 6:00 P.M., local time, in any of the following locations, excluding those spaces designated as handicap parking under Section 14-108:

Washington Street, on the east side between Maple Avenue and Curtiss Street.

<u>Section 3</u>. That all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

**Section 4.** That this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication in the manner provided by law.

File # 15-13 – Washington St. - Maple to Curtiss - New Parking Restrictions - Mr.

**Fera** referred to the map location on the overhead, discussing the current on-street parking restrictions, how they were determined, and how they were working. To date, he was requesting to make the entire section a two-hour parking restriction, noting the curb cuts would be protected and they were much cleaner looking.
