Fire Hydrant Painting - The Village's hydrant painting contractor, Giant Maintenance, began work this week. They are contracted to paint 523 hydrants in the area between the railroad tracks and 55th Street. The work will include the downtown area. They began their work on the east side of town and will progress west, completing the work in three to four weeks. The work includes removing the old finish by blasting, priming and then painting with the final color.

Neighborhood Meeting Scheduled for Clyde Estates - A public meeting is scheduled for Wednesday, August 13th, 6:30 p.m., at the Public Works Building to discuss the 2015 planned improvements in the Clyde Estates Subdivision. The work will include the reconstruction of streets, drainage improvements and the construction of new sidewalks. The purpose of the meeting is to share maps, exhibits and preliminary plans with residents and to solicit input from the neighborhood.
