**2014 Pedestrian Improvements** - The construction of new sidewalks, and the maintenance of existing sidewalks for 2014 is substantially complete. Restoration of the disturbed areas will take place in September and staff will finalize the contracts. The Safe Walk to School contract is also substantially complete, which included the improvements at Blodgett and Randall, as well as walkways at three schools. In addition to these projects, two

ADA improvements have been completed, the first at McCollum Park and the second at St. Joseph's school.
