SYNOPSIS

At the September 9, 2014 meeting, under New Business, Mayor Tully requested staff to prepare a report on the Community Grants Commission that would facilitate Council discussion of re-instating the community grants program.

STRATEGIC PLAN ALIGNMENT

The goals for 2011-2018 include Exceptional Municipal Services.

FISCAL IMPACT

If the Council were to fund community grants in the FY15 budget, the cost of the program would be \$68,800 (8% of the estimated hotel tax revenue of \$860,000). Funding the program at this level without making other changes to the budget would increase General Fund expenses by \$68,800.

RECOMMENDATION

Action at the discretion of the Village Council.

BACKGROUND

The Community Grants Program exists to provide, on a discretionary basis, under the sole discretion of the Downers Grove Village Council, monetary grants to not-for-profit organizations to promote, conduct or sponsor community oriented activities that contribute to the quality of life for Village residents. The Mayor, subject to confirmation by the Village Council, appoints the seven members on this Board, who serve three-year terms and one student member who serves a one-year term.

On December 21, 2004, Village Council passed an ordinance whereby the amount of funds for the Downers Grove Community Grants Program would be established on an annual basis through the normal budgeting process and shall equal eight percent (8%) of the Downers Grove Hotel Tax generated in the fiscal year preceding the budget year or \$48,000, whichever is greater. The amount budgeted shall be exclusive of any donations. The Community Grants Commission develops criteria for use as guidelines in the preparation and review of grant requests. Priority is typically given to projects that include the following criteria:

- Celebrate and contribute to the cultural arts in the community
- Contribute to the positive image of the Village
- Introduce new events or activities to Downers Grove
- Demonstrate sound management practices by their sponsors
- Indicate sources of funding in addition to the Village grant request
- Attract visitors to Downers Grove
- Provide activities open to the public
- Demonstrate the potential to become financially self-sustaining

• Take place in Downers Grove

In 2010, the Village suspended the community grants program as part of the restructuring of the General Fund.

Impact on the Proposed FY15 Budget

If the Council were to fund community grants in the FY15 budget, the cost of the program would be \$68,800 (8% of the estimated hotel tax revenue of \$860,000). Funding the program at this level without making other changes to the budget would increase General Fund expenses by \$68,800.

If the Village had funded the community grants program in FY14, the cost of the program would have been \$68,800 (8% of the estimated hotel tax revenue of \$860,000).
