Public Meeting for 55th Street Improvements

DuPage County is hosting an informational meeting on Thursday, November 20, concerning improvements being proposed along 55th Street from Dunham Road to Clarendon Hills Road. The meeting will be conducted in an open house style format between the hours of 4 pm and 7 pm in the Auditorium of the Lincoln Center, 935 Maple Avenue. The proposed work includes:

- Resurfacing 55th Street from Dunham Road to Williams Street;
- Widening the intersections with Main Street and Fairview Avenue to provide exclusive left turn lanes on all approaches;
- Traffic signal modernization;
- Traffic signal interconnection between Dunham Road and Clarendon Hills Road;
- Retaining walls and sidewalk repairs; and
- Accessibility improvements.
