G. Resolution: Authorize an Extension and Amendment to the Agreement with Hey and Associates, Inc.

How does the Village use the results of the investigation in determining future storm sewer maintenance and capital improvements?

The Village uses these investigations on as-needed basis when residents contact the Village about drainage concerns or when a project is planned in the area. If a drain tile is located, the flow is re-routed to the storm sewer system. If a storm sewer is not in close proximity, the drain tile is repaired or replaced if necessary. When drain tiles are found to be located on private property, information about their location is provided to the property owner for their repair.
