BACKGROUND

The following summary paragraph appears on the Village's Facilities Planning webpage - http://www.downers.us/govt/village-managers-office/facilities-planning (along with additional background and historical information):

The Village owns and operates seven major buildings that must be properly maintained. Five buildings are in a maintainable condition of Excellent, Good or Fair. The Police Station and Village Hall are in Below Average condition and do not provide modern work spaces that allow for efficient and effective interactions among employees and customers. Both facilities have outdated major building systems that will require significant investment to replace.

The only recent activity related to this project includes the following:

1. On March 10, 2015, the following top story was posted to the Village website:

Facilities Planning on Hold Due to Potential Loss of State Shared Revenues

Given the uncertainty regarding the proposed state budget, which calls for substantial reductions in revenue shared with municipalities and may include a property tax freeze, the Village will not be

proceeding with its facilities planning efforts at this time. The proposed information release and resident survey will not be completed as originally planned and scheduled.

It is likely that this topic of planning for future facility needs will be addressed again by the Village Council during the summer as part of the Village's Long Range Planning process.
