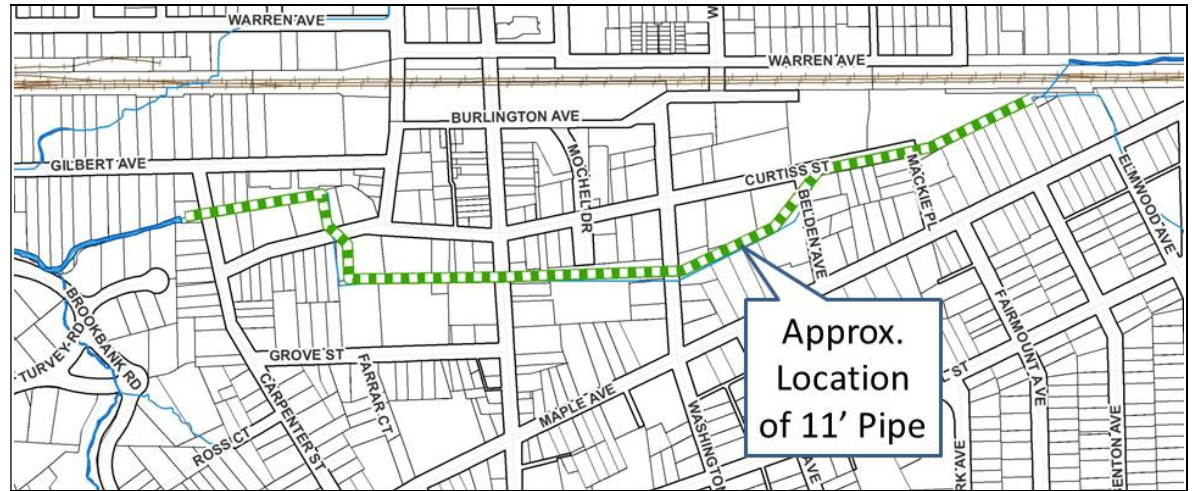

Re: Inspection of 11 foot Diameter Pipe through Downtown Business District

Dear Residents and Business Owners,

The Village will begin inspection of the 11 foot diameter pipe which carries water from St. Joseph’s Creek through the Downtown Business District (DBD) the week of October 3. This pipe, the general location of which is shown below, is an important feature of the Village’s stormwater management system. In some areas the pipe runs beneath the street, parking lots and building structures. The inspection requires that water be removed from the pipe.



To perform this work, personnel will be present at the east end, west end and at a few intermediate sections of the pipe. Removing the water and inspecting the pipe is expected to begin October 5. Once started this work will take 24 to 72 continuous hours to complete. Below is a summary of what to expect:

- Continuous pumping at the west end of the pipe into St. Joseph’s Creek for 24 to 72 hours using low-decibel pumps and generators
- Lights used at night
- Personnel entering/exiting the pipe at the east end near Village Hall and at intermediate locations along the route
- Personnel walking on the ground above the pipe to ensure the safety of inspection personnel

This work is extremely sensitive to weather conditions, which may impact the project schedule. Please contact me if you have any questions or concerns.
