**Temporary Street Closures Planned**

Two temporary street closures are planned for the week of 7/10:

- Maple Avenue between Carpenter Street and Lane Place;
- Gilbert Street west of Forest Avenue.

Maple Avenue

On Tuesday, Swallow Construction will begin water main replacement on Maple Avenue between Carpenter Street and Lane Place. Due to staging of construction equipment and materials, traffic will be detoured around the construction via Main Street and 55th Street during the day, with full east-west access available at the end of each working day. Informational message boards will be placed on Maple to alert the motoring public. Residents within the construction area will have access to their homes, however, there may be intermittent interruptions. The work and detour are expected to last three working days, weather permitting, and will be put in place again in approximately two weeks to connect residential services to the new water main.

Gilbert Street

Gilbert Street will be closed to traffic from Forest Avenue to about 200 feet west of Forest Avenue on Sunday through Monday. This will allow the contractor to install a new storm sewer to service the new development at 5100 Forest Avenue. Motorists will have access to Immanuel Residences and to the commuter parking lot behind Immanuel Residences.
