Fire Hydrant Training Conducted

During the last week of the year staff from the Public Works and Fire Departments conducted Fire Hydrant/Water System training with all three Fire Department shifts. Also in attendance were representatives from the manufacturer of the fire hydrants as well as the contractor who performs leak detection, valve exercising and hydrant maintenance. The discussions included fire hydrant flow testing, hydrant maintenance, a general overview of the fire hydrants the Village uses, common problems/troubleshooting issues, and the proper way to open and close fire hydrant valves. The purpose of the training was to reduce potential damage that can occur when fire hydrants are operated during emergency conditions.
