Public Hearings

A. PUB 2018-7885 - 2019 Budget Public Hearing

How much does the Village pay for electricity for streetlight operations on a monthly basis? The Village pays approximately \$12,000 per month for electricity to power streetlights.

What does the Village pay for all electricity?

The Village pays about \$243,000 per year for electricity, including streetlights.

How much does the Village save due to the franchise agreement with ComEd? ComEd has provided the following credits to the Village of Downers Grove pursuant to the franchise agreement.

What is the plan to address the existing sidewalk gaps in the Village?

Sidewalk gaps exist on streets where the sidewalk is not continuous on a block because a portion is missing. The primary reasons for missing sections of sidewalk are lack of public right of way, environmental factors and coordination with private development activities. The attached map shows the locations of sidewalks in the Village.

In 2018 examples of sidewalk gaps that will be completed are on Brookbank Road south of 59th Street, on Lacey Road north of Finley Road, and on Ogden Avenue with the Packey Webb development. These gaps were eliminated in conjunction with public and private construction.

The Village plans on constructing sidewalks to fill gaps on an annual basis. In 2019 the Village is planning to eliminate additional sidewalk gaps on Ogden Avenue, as well as continue to eliminate identified sidewalk gaps.

Please give an assessment on the EAB Treatment program now that the program is almost concluded.

Please see the attached status report from the Village Forester.

A number of both private and parkway trees seem to be in noticeably bad condition throughout the Village. Is there any particular reason, and can it be addressed? Could an assessment of tree health in the community be provided?

Publications from The Morton Arboretum, the U of I Extension service, and IL Dept of Natural Resources are all relaying reports of increased tree mortality but no one definitive cause. The following is a summary:

In general, stressing situations can predispose trees to change chemically (physiologically) which then makes them more vulnerable to secondary pathogens such as disease and insect pests. Predisposing factors include drought, floods, severe winter temperatures, de-icing salts, and construction activities. Regardless of the cause(s), the general model for dieback/decline of any plant is as follows:

- 1. Healthy trees + stress leads to altered tree tissues (dieback begins)
- 2. Altered trees + more stress leads to altered tree tissues (dieback continues)
- 3. Severely altered trees and tissues leads to organisms of secondary action and tree tissues are invaded.

With each step, trees lose the ability to respond to improved conditions, and continue to decline and perhaps dies. This progression may occur in a very short period of time (i.e. flooding) or be extended over a period of months or even years depending on the extent of the stress(es) and the overall health of the tree.

At this point, it looks like the bad weather conditions of the past several years are impacting trees of all ages and species. Staff has noted higher mortalities of even the toughest tree species like the honeylocust.

The best advice is all related to care and more can be posted: Provide adequate water during dry periods, provide adequate nutrition, do not over fertilize, properly mulch, properly prune by removing the three D's (dead, dying, and diseased branches), protect from de-icing salts, protect from root damage, and protect from defoliating agents.


RE: Ash Tree Status Update

Purpose

The purpose of this communication is to provide information regarding the current status of parkway ash trees and the impact of Emerald Ash Borer (EAB) on these ash trees.

BACKGROUND

The amount of canopy dieback is annually assessed to determine the effectiveness of EAB treatments and measure the health of the parkway ash tree population. The figure below shows the canopy dieback rating system with 0% for no dieback, and then increments of 10 up to 100% where the entire tree is dead.



The following table lists the number of ash in each canopy dieback rating percentage as of October 2018.

Since 2006, parkway ash tree numbers have declined by more than 2960 trees. Ash once comprised more than 19% of the parkway tree inventory, but now are less than 7% of the total. Green Ash in particular has decreased the most. The following table highlights the changes.

A variety of EAB preventative treatments have been applied over the years, which in turn has slowed down the rate of ash tree losses, and kept the removal and replacement workload manageable. Staff is pleased to report that 82% of the remaining ash trees have low canopy dieback ratings of 0 to 30%. White ash has responded well to EAB treatments, both in terms of low canopy dieback ratings and fewer removals. This is fortunate for white ash has a pleasing form and beautiful fall color. The remaining number of green ash is also greater than expected, which is a pleasant surprise given that green ash declined rapidly as EAB entered the area. Overall, ash tree removals in 2018 are lower than last year.

In terms of CIP Project FO-001-Emerald Ash Borer (EAB) Eradication budget, requests for future years have been reduced due to account for fewer removals and subsequently fewer replacement plantings. The following table highlights the dollars for the 6 year timeframe.

The one positive has been that replanting activities have focused on a diversity of tree species. In all cases, the adjacent property is notified of the tree removal and offered tree species choices for replanting when space allows. Staff has been able to honor requests such that 45% or more of the plantings are tree species chosen by the adjacent resident.


PROJECTED WORK PLAN

Staff anticipates the following plan and course of action:

• Continue treating parkway ash trees with canopy dieback ratings of 0 to 30, currently 1290 trees

- Re-evaluate trees with moderate EAB and canopy dieback ratings of 40 to 60 to see if continued treatment is warranted or if removal is required, currently 231 trees
- Re-evaluate trees with significant EAB and canopy dieback ratings of 70 to 100 to determine removal needs, currently 27 trees
- Remove designated ash trees, currently 10 trees
- Re-evaluate all ash trees annually to assess canopy dieback percentages
- Continue timely removal of ash trees as they are marked throughout the year
- Replant as many replacement trees as practical and honor species requests in the next planting season (spring or fall) following a removal or request
- Continue to monitor research activities with treatments and EAB populations
