7. First Reading, A. ORD 2019-8354 An ordinance amending disabled parking provisions

Did the state increase the fines for illegally parking in a handicap space? What are the fines? Will all of the signs in the spaces stating the fines need to be changed to reflect the current fines?

No, the fines were not increased; illegally parking in a reserved disabled parking space still carries a fine of \$250.00 according to State law. The proposed ordinance amending disabled parking provisions that is being presented at the October 15, 2019 Council meeting would allow officers to cite an individual abusing disabled parking privileges by displaying placards or license plates not issued to them.

7. First Reading, B. MOT 2019-8358 A motion awarding \$323,651.55 to H&H Electric Company for traffic signal modernization at the intersection of Finley Road and Finley Square Mall
