SYNOPSIS

A motion is requested to authorize a change order to an existing three-year contract for Specialty Winter Operations Services with Snow Systems, Inc. of Wheeling, Illinois in the amount of \$60,000.

STRATEGIC PLAN ALIGNMENT

The goals for 2019-2021 include Exceptional Municipal Services.

FISCAL IMPACT

The FY20 budget, and the proposed FY21 budget include \$135,000 for this service in the General Fund. The proposed change order would increase the existing contract amount from \$323,977.50 to \$383,977.50.

RECOMMENDATION

Approval on the October 6, 2020 consent agenda.

BACKGROUND

In June 2018, the Village awarded a three-year contract to Snow Systems, Inc. of Wheeling, Illinois, in the amount of \$323,977.50. To determine the contract amount, staff estimated the number of times the contractor would be called for service based upon an average winter. The contract provides a unit price to clear snow and salt, and to salt only. Staff anticipated 20 events for snow clearing with salting and 10 salt only events on an annual basis, totaling an average amount of \$108,000 per year. The 2018/2019 winter saw an above average snowfall, resulting in 53 total events, for a total cost of \$166,785. As a result, there likely is not enough left in the contract for the 2020/2021 season.

The purpose of the recommended change order is to provide adequate spending authority to complete the third year of the three year contract, in the total amount of \$133,587.50. This amount would provide snow clearing and salting services for a winter season with an above average number of snow and ice events. The unit prices for service provided by the competitively bid contract would remain in place. The contractor has provided service in a timely and professional manner and staff recommends funding the third year of this contract with Snow Systems Inc.
