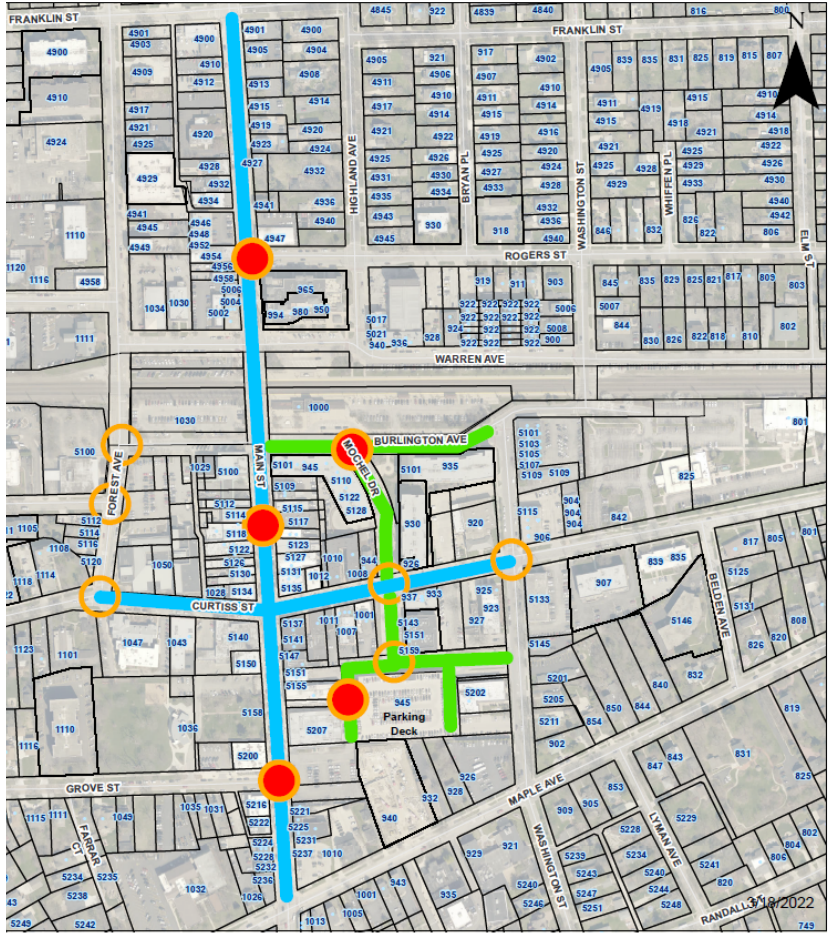
Coffee with the Council - Coffee with the Council will be held **Saturday, April 9th at 9:00 a.m.** at the **Downers Grove Public Library**.

This week, work began on the 2022 Downtown Business District (DBD) Crosswalk & Accessibility Improvements. This phase of the DBD Crosswalk and Accessibility Upgrades includes the intersections at:

- Burlington Avenue & Mochel Drive
- Main Street & Rogers Street
- Main Street & Grove Street
- Main Street and the mid-block crosswalk between Burlington Avenue & Curtiss Street
- The pedestrian entrances on the East and West sides of the Downtown Parking Deck

All existing sidewalk materials will be replaced with colored concrete matching the rest of the DBD. All existing crosswalk material within each intersection will be replaced and topped with a highly visible and durable material in a decorative red brick pattern. The DBD crosswalk upgrades constructed in 2021 will also receive the same decorative red brick topping pattern. This project is one of many Village projects taking place in the DBD this year, all of which are shown in the map below.
