1. Does the cyber liability policy cover cyber extortion payments?

Yes, the proposed cyber liability and crime combined policy covers cyber extortion payments up to \$3 million above a \$1 million self-insured retention. The proposed policy was revised on December 5 to expand the cyber liability coverage.
