

## **Responses to Village Council Questions March 3, 2026**

### **CONSENT AGENDA: MOT 2026-11162 C. Motion: Approving an Agreement with Fox Excavating of Batavia, Illinois for 2026 Storm Sewer Replacement & Maintenance**

- 1. This contract amount is greater than the amount budgeted and the balance will be paid with funds available in the Stormwater Fund. Is staff concerned that this will cause an issue in the Stormwater Fund going forward?*

Additional funds are available for the balance of this project from cost savings from other stormwater projects being constructed. The budgeted FY26 ending cash balance in the Stormwater Fund is \$4.5 million. Therefore, staff is not concerned this will cause an issue going forward.

### **CONSENT AGENDA: RES 2026-11159 D. Resolution: Approving a First Extension to the Agreement with SEECO Consultants, Inc. for Material Testing Services**

### **CONSENT AGENDA: RES 2026-11160 E. Resolution: Approving a First Extension to the Agreement with ECS Midwest, LLC. for Material Testing Services**

- 1. What type of materials testing will be completed under these contracts?*

Material testing completed under these contracts include various concrete strength testing, asphalt compaction and density testing. Testing also includes compaction testing of backfill material on various projects.

### **CONSENT AGENDA: MOT 2026-11161 F. Motion: Approving an Agreement with Lyons Electric for Streetlight Replacement Program**

- 1. The staff report indicates that a large area south of 63rd Street has been excluded from this work. Why was it excluded and when will streetlights in this area be replaced?*

Streetlights are being replaced in phases. The number of streetlights replaced each year is based on the amounts included in annual budgets. Staff prioritized the streetlight systems along the main roads. The remaining streetlights will be replaced in 2027 as part of the annual streetlight replacement program.

**FIRST READING: MOT 2026-11163 A. Motion: Approving an Agreement with Builders Paving, LLC for 2026 Street Resurfacing**

- 1. After spending the \$3,448,400 for this contract, \$491,600 will remain in the budget for other maintenance activities including street patching. Is the amount sufficient to complete the maintenance activities planned for this year?*

The remaining funds are sufficient to complete the scheduled fall street patching improvements (approx. \$100,000) and the crack sealing contract (approx. \$96,000) that will be awarded later this year.
