

## Responses to Village Council Questions March 10, 2026

**ORD 2026-11147** E. Ordinance: Amending the Zoning Ordinance of the Village of Downers Grove, Illinois, to Designate the Property at 5112-5120 Forest Avenue and a Portion of 1108-1114 Curtiss Street as Planned Unit Development #74

1. *Please provide a summary of the landscape plan. In general, what types of landscaping will be planted and in what locations? Does the plan call for the use of native plants?*

The landscape plan principally provides landscaping along the Forest Avenue and Curtiss Street facades. Along Gilbert Avenue, there is a landscaping bed located in the parkway. The plants are made up of deciduous shrubs, an evergreen shrub, ornamental grasses, perennials and groundcovers. Of the 309 plants proposed to be planted, only six (6) plants, the Chicagoland Green Boxwood, are non-native.
